SEMPA Education Committee

The SEMPA Education Committee will make recommendations for and direct the planning and implementation of education meeting(s) as well as education tools and resources, in addition to the marketing of educational offerings.

Objectives:

- 1. Research and evaluation
 - a. Assess long-range planning needs
 - b. Review needs assessment, evaluations and comments, market research, and other data to determine member educational needs
 - c. Identify gaps in educational offerings
 - d. Utilize emergency physicians, groups and advisors to help further determine the emergency medicine knowledge, skills and practice needs for the EMPA
- 2. For educational meeting(s), develop and finalize educational programs
 - a. Review reports, surveys and course evaluations and recommend any needed changes
 - b. Develop course objectives
 - c. Determine educational topics
 - d. Develop course schedule
 - e. Determine the faculty
 - f. Provide assistance in ensuring faculty submit their materials (syllabus, faculty contracts, disclosure forms, etc.) in a timely manner
- 3. Identify emerging trends in emergency medicine CME and develop recommendations for new products and future direction of existing products
- 4. Pursue strategic partnerships with organizations that will contribute to the continuing medical education goals and objectives of EMPAs
- 5. Develop and plan targeted educational meetings outside of SEMPA 360 to enhance the educational offerings of SEMPA (ie. procedure course, ultrasound course, etc.)
