SEMPA EMS Committee

The SEMPA EMS Committee will make recommendations for and direct the research, evaluation and policies of PAs in EMS as well as identify trends and strategic partnerships to advance the practice goals of EMSPAs.

Objectives:

- 1. Research and evaluation
 - a. Identify the number of EMSPA practicing
 - b. Review needs assessment, evaluations and comments, and other data to determine member advocacy needs
 - c. Identify gaps in EMSPA training and experience
 - d. Utilize emergency physicians, EMS organizations and advisors to help further determine the emergency medicine knowledge, skills and practice needs for the EMPA

2. Policy

- a. Review state and national guideline regarding EMSPA practice
- b. Advocate for appropriate usage of the PA in EMS
- c. Develop recommendations for the SEMPA Board of Directors to advance policy
- 3. Identify emerging trends in EMS and develop resources to support the EMSPA
- 4. Pursue strategic partnerships with organizations that will contribute to the practice goals and objectives of EMSPAs
